## Day One

This study is designed to help you to develop a stronger trust in the Lord. Nothing could be more profitable or helpful to you in your life. To do this study, you will need a Bible, a pen and notebook, a quiet place, a hungry heart and mind, a willingness to think and work, and some time. Take your Bible and look up the Bible verses listed in this study.

Each day write out the verses in the space provided, and in the following space write out what the verse says about trust, keep in mind the following questions as you describe what the verse says about trust.

In whom or what should we trust? What is involved in trusting? What does trusting mean? In whom or what shouldn't we trust? Why should we or can we trust? Why shouldn't we or can't we trust? When should we or can we trust? What are the results or effects of trust? What are the results or effects of a lack of trust? Evaluate your life in the light of what you have learned from this passage. What does this passage indicate about your trust or confidence level? What can you do to increase your confidence or trust quotient? What will you do?

Do the "Questions and Assignments" numbered 11-15 found in Day Six to make the study personal and practical.

Keep a daily record of times you are tempted to not trust. On a separate piece of paper write out answers to the questions:
